CR 423/27/07/2023	27 July 2023	BUDGET PLANNING AND INVESTMENT UNIT REPORT FOR THE QUARTER 4 ENDED 30 JUNE 2022/2023	 That, the report on the implementation of the budget and the financial state of affairs of the municipality for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 be noted and approved by council. That, the municipality's approved revenue budget amounts to R 579,6 million, the adjusted Budget was R 591,4, with the 2nd adjusted budget of R 588,1. Revenue for the month ended 30 June 2023 amounted to R 49 million. The revenue recognised to date is 92% of the total approved revenue budget and 8 % relates to the 4th quarter ending June 2023.

3. That, the municipality's approved expenditure budget of R 480 million the adjusted Budget was R 612,5 million, no adjustment has been made on the total 2nd adjusted budget operating expenditure budget. The expenditure incurred for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 amounted to R 94,4 million. Expenditure incurred to date represents 66% of the approved operating expenditure budget and 15% relates to the 4nd quarter ending June 2023. 4. That, the municipality's approved capital expenditure budget amounts R 171,3 million and the 1nd adjusted budget was R 180,9 million, with the 2nd adjusted budget of R 177,3 million. Capital Expenditure incurred for the quarter amounted to R 53,3 million, Capital expenditure to date is 79% of the total capital expenditure budget and 19% relates to the 4nd quarter ending June 2023. Capital expenditure funded by the Municipal infrastructure grant is at 100% of the allocation as at 30 June 2023. Capital expenditure funded by integrated electrification grant is at 100% of the allocation as at 30 June 2023. Capital expenditure funded by the capital replacement reserves

(CRR) is at 60% of the budget as at 30 June 2023. 5. That, the total Grants allocated to the municipality as per approved budget R 395, 7 million, the 1st amounts to adjusted budget was R 406,9 with the 2nd adjusted budget of R 403,6. o 100% has been received for equitable share, 100% for Finance Management grant has been received, Municipal 0 100% for the infrastructure grant, and 100% for the INEP grant has been received. o 100% has been received for the Expanded Public Works Incentive and 100% has been received for the Library support grant. 6. That, the total investments amounting to R 239,3 m (Conditional: R 4,6 m: Unconditional R 234,7 m) as at 30 June 2023 be noted by council. 7. The Total Cash held reflects bank balances as at 30 June 2023 is R 22,700,515 consist of the following bank balances as at June 2023.
