NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 116 (3) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL FINANCE MANAGEMENT ACT, 2003 (ACT 56 OF 2003) FOR THE AMENDMENT TO THE EXISTING CONTRACTS FOR APPOINTMENT OF PANEL OF THREE SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF GRAVEL ROADS, BRIDGES AND ALL STORMWATER RELATED WORKS FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS. THE EXTENSION OF CONTRACT PERIOD IS FROM 01 JULY 2026 TO 31 DECEMBER 2026.

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 116 (3) (a) and (b) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act 56 of 2003) that it is the intention of the Matatiele Local Municipality to amend the existing contract:

DESCRIPTION: APPOINTMENT OF PANEL OF THREE SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF GRAVEL ROADS, BRIDGES AND ALL STORMWATER RELATED WORKS FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS. THE EXTENSION OF CONTRACT PERIOD IS FROM 01 JULY 2026 TO 31 DECEMBER 2026.

SERVICE PROVIDERS: Amacwele Building and Civil Contractors, Vitsha Trading, Ngcombela Civils and Plant Hire cc, MVI Construction and Maintenance cc JV SV Gqagqane Trading (Pty) Ltd, Maboka Contractors (Pty) Ltd, Kaazi Engineering Group (Pty) Ltd, Maboka Contractors (Pty) Ltd, Masilo Projects cc, Clive 's Transport Stem-Pro (Pty) Ltd, Amandlela Engineering and Safety Consultants (Pty) Ltd JV Lakhimu Investments, Manong Construction and Projects cc

Reasons for the proposed amendment: The Municipality has a legitimate operational requirement to maintain continuity in the procurement of access road and stormwater-related works.

The existing panels remain valid until:

- 28 September 2026 in respect of MATAT/2023/2024-11; and
- 04 December 2026 in respect of MATAT/2023/2024-44.

While the existing panels remain valid, the Municipality must continue managing its infrastructure programme within the applicable contractual and legislative framework.

The Municipality would not ordinarily be able to disregard an existing valid procurement arrangement and simply procure the same services through a new panel before the expiry of the existing contractual arrangements, unless such procurement is legally permissible and properly justified.

The proposed extensions are consequently intended to ensure a controlled transition between

the existing panels and the new procurement process.

RISK OF NON-EXTENSION

Failure to extend the existing contracts, where the extension is legally permissible and properly approved, creates a potential operational and financial risk for the Municipality.

In particular, discontinuation of the existing panels without an appropriate transitional arrangement could result in delays in the implementation of approved infrastructure projects.

Such delays could negatively affect the Municipality's expenditure performance against allocated capital grants.

There is consequently a potential risk that the Municipality may fail to spend allocated grant funding within the applicable implementation periods, which could adversely affect service delivery and expose the Municipality to the risk of grant funding being withheld, surrendered or otherwise negatively affected in accordance with the applicable grant conditions.

The extension is therefore motivated not merely by administrative convenience, but by the need to protect the continuity of infrastructure delivery and ensure that allocated capital resources are utilised effectively.
